Thank you to our families and staff for their support at this time. Please continue to encourage and reinforce with your children/students the principles of hygiene and cough etiquette (regularly wash hands with soap, covering mouth and nose when sneezing, staying home if you are sick).

All staff and students who have returned from overseas, or have been in contact with someone who has just returned from overseas need to stay home for 14 days.

A reminder that any child who is unwell should not be at school. If a child becomes unwell at school parents will be advised as is the usual procedure and the student will need to go home.

The Ministry of Health suggest to following to help keep you and your family well.

- regularly washing hands (for at least 20 seconds with warm water and soap and dry thoroughly)
- covering your mouth and nose when you sneeze

- avoiding close contact with anyone with cold or flu-like symptoms
- if you feel unwell you should avoid public gatherings and events.
